

MORROW COUNTY, OHIO

LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Morrow County Enterprise Zone Tax Abatements: Manufacturing, warehouse/distribution, and research & development oriented businesses interested in expanding or locating in Morrow County may be eligible for tax abatement of real property taxes for up to 10 years. Projects must involve a substantial investment and create quality, full-time equivalent jobs.

Morrow County Community Reinvestment Area Tax Abatements: Manufacturing, warehouse/distribution, research & development, professional services, and commercial oriented businesses interested in expanding or locating in the State Route 61 and Interstate 71 interchange area in Morrow County may be eligible for tax abatement of up to 100% of real property taxes for up to 10 years. Projects must involve a substantial investment and create quality, full-time equivalent jobs.

Morrow County Revolving Loan Fund (RLF): The County RLF uses community development block grant funds to promote and assist in new business development and/or existing business expansion projects resulting in creation or retention of job opportunities for low-to-moderate income households. The County may lend up to \$500,000 in RLF funds based on \$25,000 per full-time job created.

Consolidated Electric Cooperative, Inc. Revolving Loan Fund (RLF): Consolidated Electric Cooperative Inc. manages a RLF to promote and assist in new business development and/or existing business expansion projects resulting in creation or retention of job opportunities.

Site Location Assistance: Consolidated Electric Cooperative can assist in your search for commercial and industrial sites.

Liaison Services: Consolidated Electric Cooperative can act as your liaison with state and local government entities, both in financing and permitting, to ensure that the development process meets a company's project timeframe.

Job Training Services: The Job Network, a One-Stop employment system for Delaware, Knox, Marion and Morrow Counties, through the Morrow County Job Services Office can assist employers with the following services: On-site recruiting at the employers facility or provide space at the Job Services Office; Pre-screening of job applicants customized to the employer needs; Provide facilities for interviews, scheduling of interviews and for other needs in meeting rooms equipped with audio visual support systems; Local labor market information, wage information and education/training outlook; Job profile analysis and job description templates; Job matching services using SCOTI; Advertise hiring and recruiting events in local and surrounding areas and staff assistance in the recruiting and hiring process.
